PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT FOR 11/01

In addition to the closings listed below, portions of other lots may be closed to provide prearranged reserved parking for event guests. Parking lots will be impacted as follows:

Parking Lot	Dates Impacted
22D (Yuengling Center)	Portions will be closed from Thur., 10/10 through Fri., 10/11 for Homecoming Carnival
BSN Grass Lot	Open to the USF community on Fri., 10/11. This temporary lot will close at 10:00 pm Fri., 10/11. Any remaining vehicles in the lot will receive a citation. Vehicles will not be able to leave the lot during the parade.
3A, 3B, & 3C (Theatre/MSC)	Closed on Friday, 10/11 for Parade float set up

Street Closures on Friday, October 11: Portions of Holly Drive, Palm Drive, Genshaft Drive, Alumni and Leroy Collins Boulevard will close at 6:00 pm for the 6:30 pm Homecoming Parade. Roadways will reopen after the parade has passed and roads are clear. Please plan alternate travel routes on campus to avoid these areas on Friday evening.

We recommend parking in the Beard or Laurel parking garages, which both offer convenient Bull Runner shuttle service to buildings around the impacted areas. Lots 18B and 18T, located off Sycamore Drive, may also serve as good parking lot options for those who typically park in the Yuengling Center lots.
