SUBJECT: Memorial Day Weekend Arrests

TAMPA: Between Saturday, May 28, 2016 and Monday, 30, 2016, officers from the University of South Florida Police Department conducted multiple traffic stops due to various traffic violations. During several of these traffic stops, officers detected an odor of marijuana. A search of the vehicles confirmed the presence of marijuana. The following individuals (non-USF affiliates) were arrested and charged with possession of marijuana:

- (1) Noel Delgado, 19, of Tampa, Florida. Charged with possession of cannabis over 20 grams (Felony). Released on \$2,000 bond.
- (2) Anthony Gore, 25, Pembroke Pines, Florida. Charged with possession of cannabis under 20 grams (Misdemeanor). Released on \$1,500 bond.
- (3) Alexander Woosley, 25, of Thonotosassa, Florida. Charged with possession of cannabis under 20 grams (Misdemeanor). Given notice to appear.

USF police officers also arrested Miguel Acosta, 25, of Tampa, Florida during a USF Comprehensive Safety Check Point. When officers checked Acosta's registration, they discovered that a counterfeit tag was affixed to his vehicle. Acosta was arrested without incident and charged with possession of counterfeit license plates (Felony). He was released on \$2,000 bond.
