

CANVAS NAVIGATION MENU CUSTOM LINK

REDIRECT TOOL

This tutorial will show you how to use the frequently overlooked Redirect Tool, which allows you to create a link in the main navigation menu of a Canvas course.

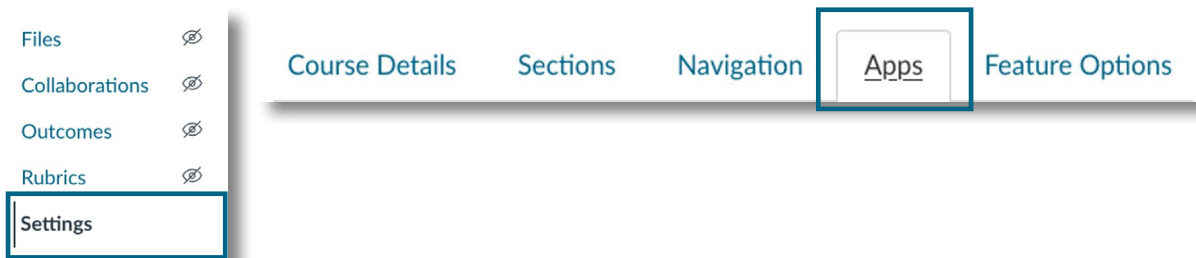
► Get the URL of the Link

Copy any link you choose to use and paste it in an open text file for retrieval later.

► Setting up the Link in Canvas

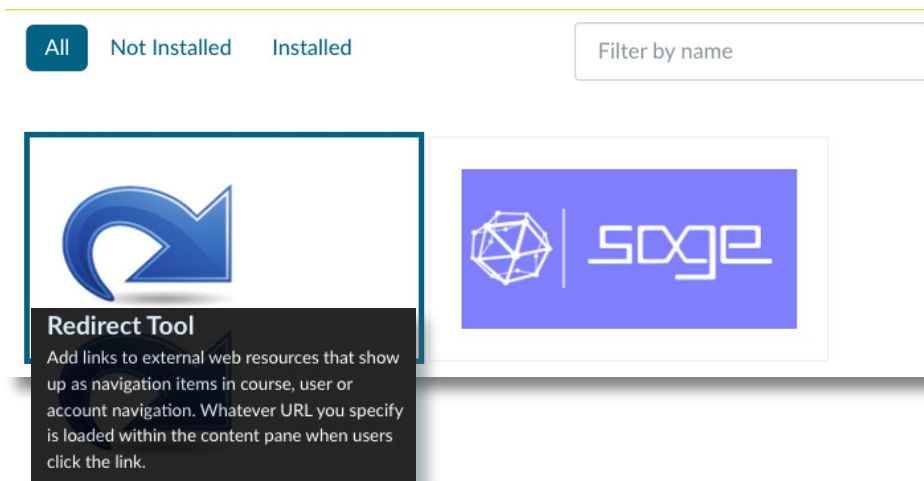

Choose **Settings** in your Canvas course, then select the **Apps** tab.

Choose the app with the image of a blue arrow. It will show the name **Redirect Tool** when you hover over it.



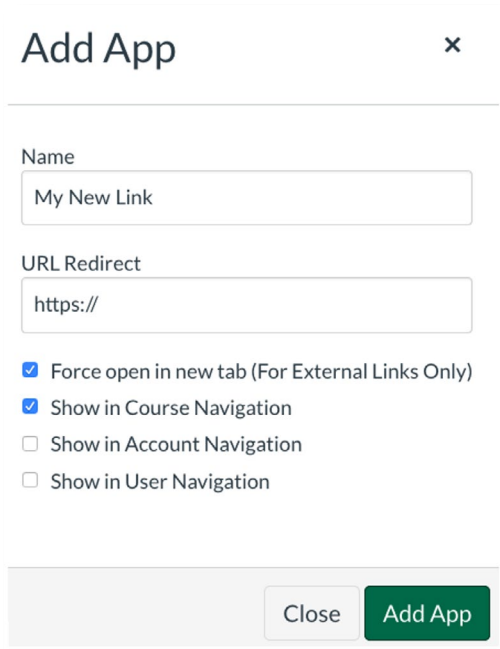

In the dialog box that appears, change the **Name** (by default, the name Redirect Tool is there) to whatever you'd like to call your link, then copy the URL from the text doc you have open and paste it into the **URL Redirect** field. Make sure that you've checked the **Force Open in New Tab** and **Show in Course Navigation** boxes, then select **Add App**.

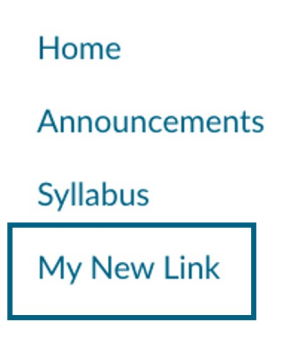

Any change in the link address (URL) will break the link you create. It will be necessary to delete the link and create a new one.

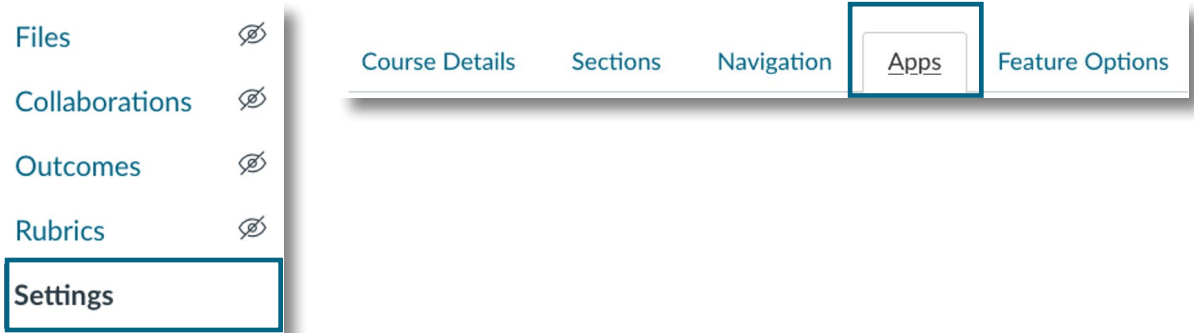

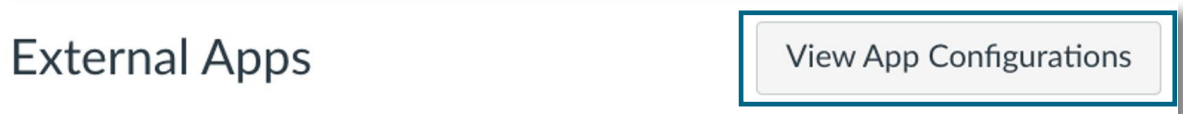

01 Choose **Settings** in your Canvas course, then select the **Apps** tab.



02 Choose **View App Configurations** at the top of the page.



03 In the list that appears, find your link, select the **gear icon**, and then **Delete**.
