

SENIOR AUDITOR APPLICATION STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

WHO IS THIS GUIDE FOR?

Florida residents 60 years of age or older who wish to take a USF course for personal enrichment and participate only as a listener. Students will not earn credits/grades and tuition/fees are waived.

STEP 1: START APPLICATION

Visit our website to begin your **Senior Citizen Audit Application**.

STEP 2: COMPLETE PERSONAL INFO

Enter all personal information, including your name, social security number, term/year of registration, gender, date of birth, address, email, telephone, emergency contact, citizenship and race.

STEP 3: ACADEMIC INTEREST

Indicate the term you are applying for. Select the specific campus where you will be taking classes (St. Petersburg, Sarasota-Manatee, or Tampa) and indicate that you are a (ND) Senior Citizen Auditor.

STEP 4: ANSWER CONDUCT QUESTIONS

Please indicate any conduct situations you have been involved in prior to this application.

STEP 5: INDICATE MILITARY AFFILIATIONS

Please indicate any military information for either yourself or your immediate family members.

STEP 6: COMPLETE RESIDENCY INFORMATION

Please indicate your residency information. To claim
Florida residency and qualify for waived tuition
and fees, you will be required to provide TWO
forms of proof that you are a Florida resident.
Otherwise, you will be classified as a non-Florida
resident and pay out-of-state tuition rates.

STEP 7: COMPLETE AND SUBMIT

Once submitted, you will receive a confirmation page to the email address you indicated on your application.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

If your application is accepted, you will receive a welcome letter from the University of South Florida with your next steps.
